




Day 1: Bogotá






Day 4: Coffee Region

- Dinner on your own (not included) at one of Medellín many amazing restaurants.



Monday, May 5, 2024


- Enjoy a relaxing morning on your own exploring Cartagena.

 before a farewell dinner nearby.


