Havana, Cuba

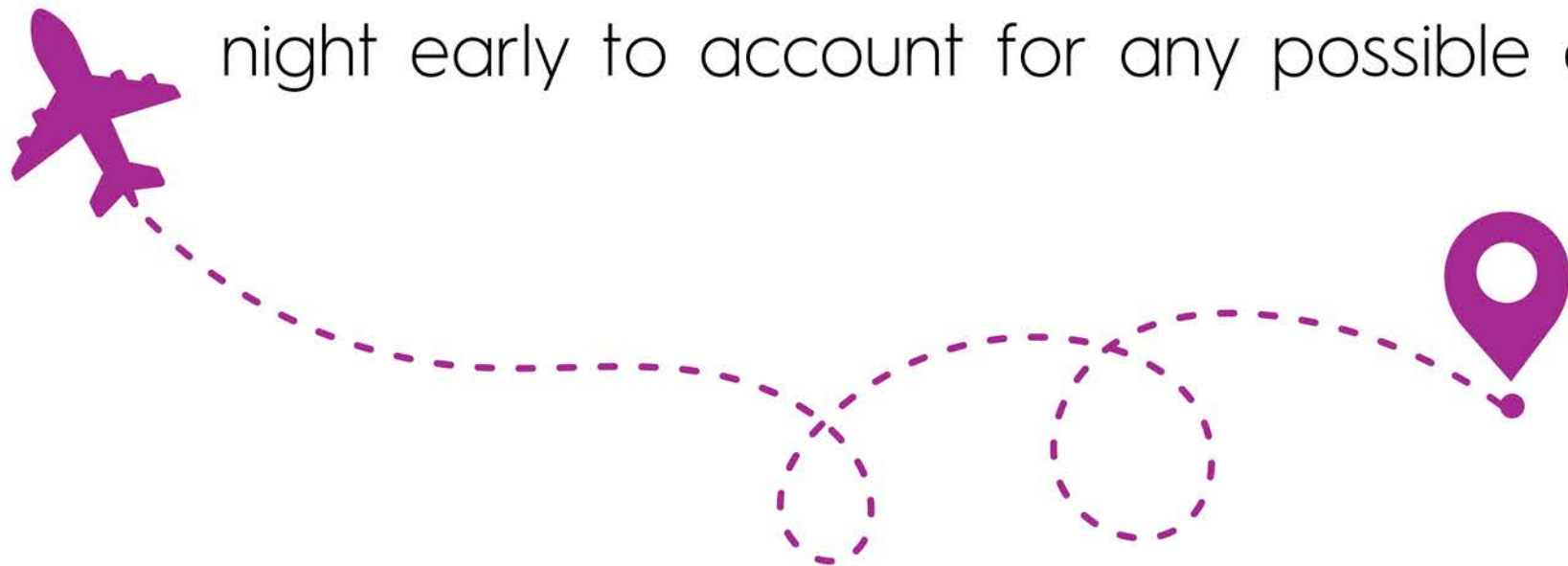
Over the past 25 years, The Joyce has hosted dozens of research and educational trips to Cuba in support of the Cuban People, establishing meaningful relationships with their artistic community and helping to bridge the gap with the nearby country through cultural exchange. In 2011, this effort culminated with the first U.S. tour of Cuba's premiere contemporary dance company-Danza Contemporanea de Cuba-including the company's New York premiere at The Joyce Theater. Since then, The Joyce has developed an expanded Cuba initiative including an arts administration workshop in Havana; internships for Cuban professional arts administrators in New York City; the creation of a new work by Brooklyn-based choreographer Ronald K. Brown for a Cuban company of his choice; and the U.S. debut of Malpaso Dance Company-at The Joyce Theater in May 2014.



Day 1: Miami, Florida

January 25, 2026

- Meet at the Miami International Airport. The group will travel together from the U.S. to Cuba.
- International flights from Miami, FL to Cuba are included in the travel package.
- Flights from your origin location to Miami, FL are not included.
- We strongly recommend arriving in Miami a night early to account for any possible delays.





Day 1: Havana, Cuba

January 25, 2026

- Upon arrival, check into the Iberostar Marques de la Torre Hotel in the Vieja neighborhood.
- Enjoy a traditional Cuban dinner at local favorite, La Guarida with special guests from the Cuban dance community.
- Attend a performance at the Havana Jazz Festival (programming TBD).

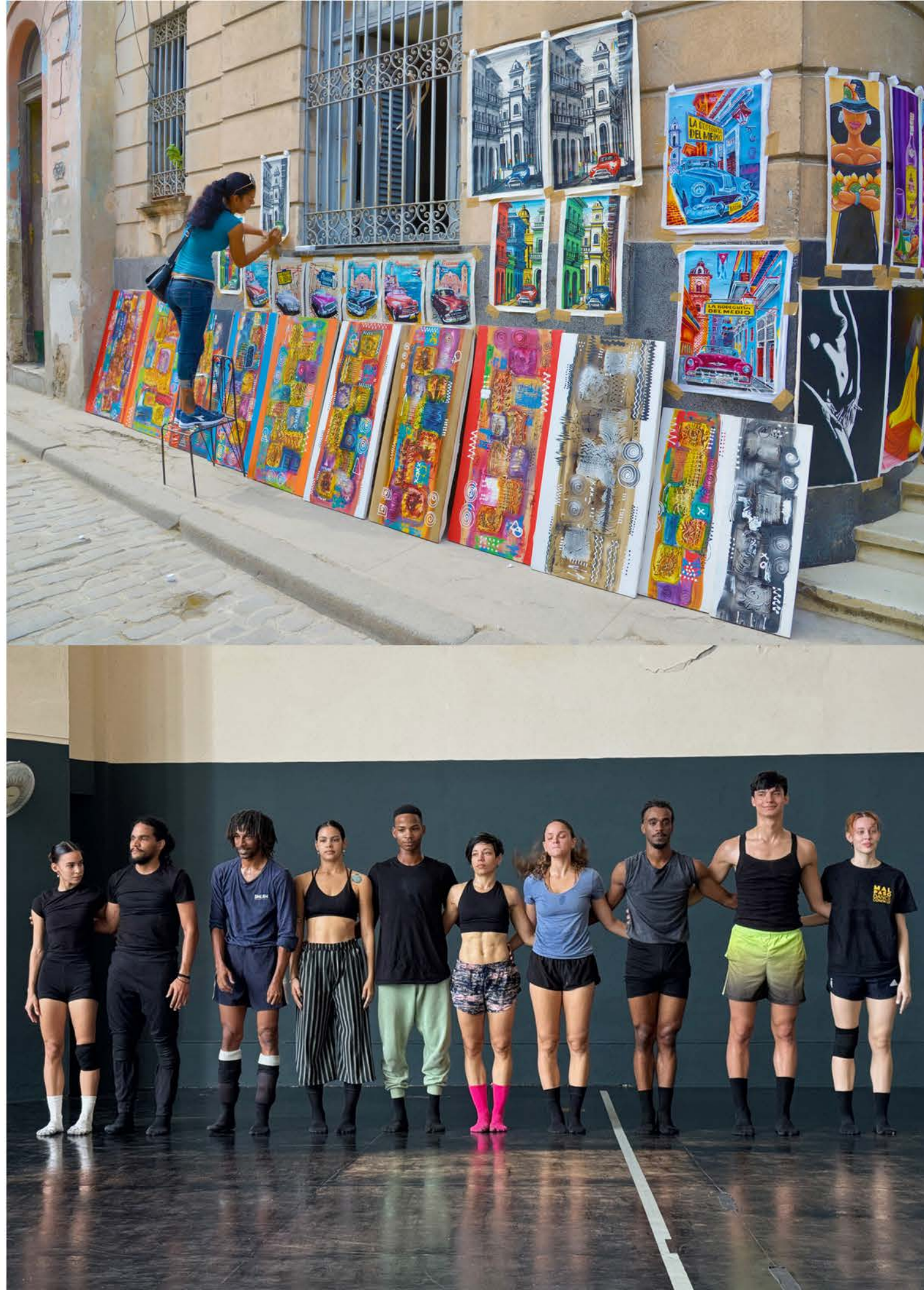


Day 2: Havana, Cuba

January 26, 2026

- Learn about the rich history and charm of Old Havana during a guided walking tour.
- Brows local goods at the Havana Arts & Crafts Market.
- Enjoy a lunch of Cuba favorites at Paladar Moneda Cubana.
- Visit the National Folkloric Company celebrating the origins of dance in the Caribbean.
- Savor an elegant outdoor dinner at Paladar Atelier.
- See Malpaso Dance Company perform at the Martí Theater.





Day 3: Havana, Cuba

January 27, 2026

- Visit the National Ballet of Cuba for a private studio rehearsal.
- Enjoy lunch at Paladar Dacameron.
- Visit the Sphardi Center including the Holocaust Museum.
- Join Malpaso Dance Company for a private showing and conversation with Executive Director Fernando Saez.
- Dine by the sea at Vista Mar.
- Catch a late night show at the Havana Jazz Festival (programming TBD).

Day 4: La Terrazas, Cuba

January 28, 2026

- Spend the day exploring Las Terrazas, a small historic nature reserve and UNESCO World Heritage Site just outside the city.
- See a performance at the Havana Jazz Festival (programming TBD) and enjoy dinner on your own exploring Havana (recommendations available).



Day 5: Havana, Cuba

January 29, 2026

- Visit the home of Danza Contemporánea de Cuba to watch a private dance class and rehearsal.
- Enjoy lunch at Paladar ChaChaCha.
- Take a guided tour of the National Museum of Fine Arts' Cuban Collection.
- Dine at the famous San Cristóbal.

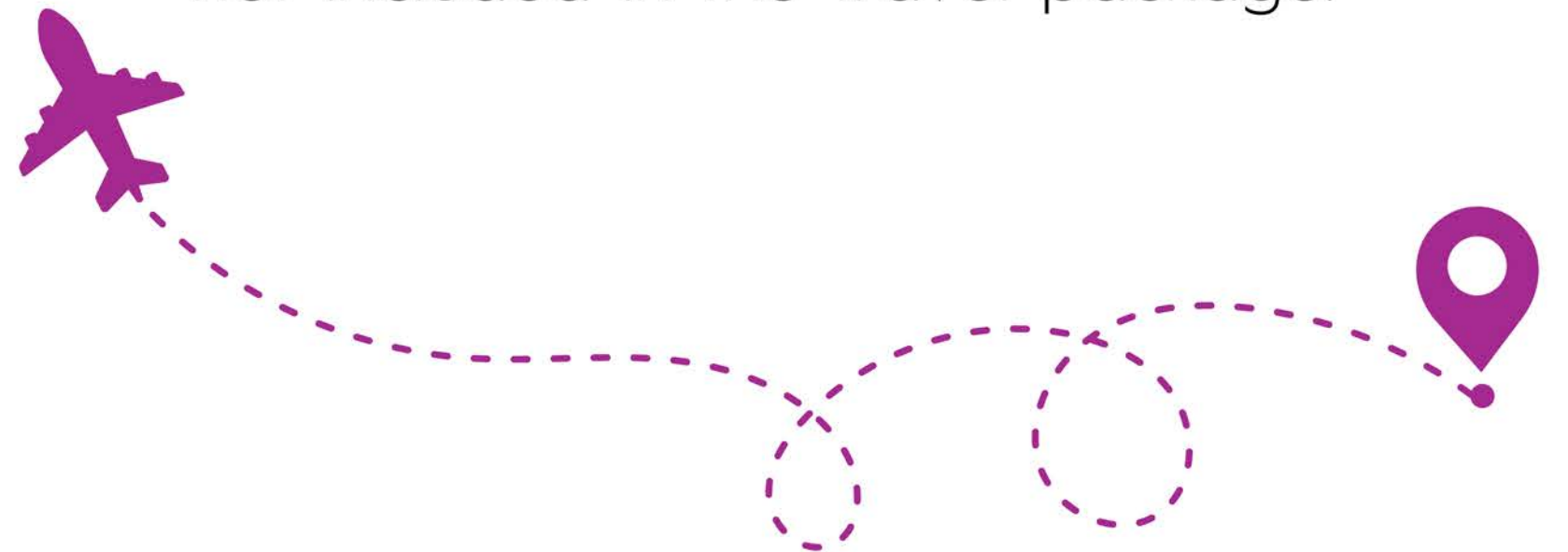




Day 6: Havana, Cuba

January 30, 2026

- After breakfast, check out of the hotel and travel back to Miami International Airport to continue on for your final destination.
- Return flights from Havana, Cuba to Miami International Airport are included in the travel package.
- Flights from Miami to your final destination not included in the travel package.
